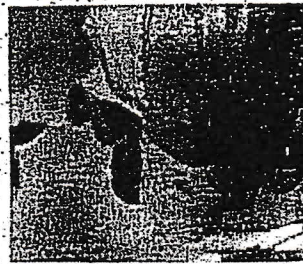

Honoring her birthday last weekend, Queen Mother Moore, Minister Without Portfolio, hosted three days of entertainment on property she owns in the N.Y. Catskill resort area. Guests were from places as distant as Detroit, Philadelphia, and Pittsburgh.

New Africans may soon have their own money. The Cabinet is contemplating the minting of gold coins, to be used as the official medium of exchange in subjugated areas. This word comes from Minister of Finance, Ray Willis, Detroit, and Treasurer Obaboa Awolo, Los Angeles.

Brother Galdi (First Vice President Milton Henry), must hustle to keep ahead of speaking engagements. He recently appeared before a national lawyers guild in California, the Black Arts Festival in Detroit, and before television cameras in New York, along with Mother Moore. Wherever Galdi goes, he makes clear the difference between segregation and separation: one is weak, one is strong.

From throughout the United States, letters are arriving expressing interest in separatism and The Republic, says Brother Imari, Minister of Information. Following such interest, latest consulates were established in Pennsylvania and Maryland, others are under consideration in Florida and Kentucky.

Brother Omar Bay, Chicago Consul, was in Detroit recently to study petition activity. Since this was the anniversary week of Detroit's rebellion, he collected signatures along 12th Street, which was ablaze a year ago.

The next legislative session probably will not occur until October, says Ray Willis, Minister of Finance, who is in addition the temporary Speaker of the National Council of Representatives. He says that returns from queries sent to consuls indicate no pressing need for further legislation.
